Jesus said in reference to Himself, *'The Son of man will be delivered into the hands of men, and they will put him to death, but after his death, on the third day, he will rise again'.*

In this life, we may sow in tears, but following Jesus Our Lord, we will rejoice in Heaven with the Angels in the next.
