Dear parishioners,

Our Lord Jesus Christ tells us in this Sunday's gospel: *'If anyone wants to be a follower of mine, let him renounce himself and take up his cross and follow me'*. The self is: all of me, all of you, every part of life we are called to give to Christ the King. That can often begin by giving up *parts* of our lives: like our time for the service or material assistance to others even if we don't feel like it. And if you do something good that you don't feel like doing, there's great merit in that. There's no harm in admitting it to yourself and God if you don't feel like doing it. We can put a brave face on it for others, but start out with the truth before God: there's nothing bad in that. Indeed, the small sacrifices we make, when we admit we don't feel like making them, are all the greater. When we do something, we don't like doing for the good or happiness of others, that's the kind of *little* thing we can do to renounce the self and follow Jesus, our Lord.

As a young man, Fr Christopher heard that call of Jesus to serve him as priest and followed the Lord through ministry in this and many other parishes for decades. Fr Christopher has been a great friend and support to many people, including your new parish priest on his journey to priesthood and since. Indeed, he has always had a keen eye and ear to vocation in the church and has supported many in responding to the Lord's call. Fr Christopher is returning to Ramsgate next weekend to say masses and for a farewell party and the presentation of the gift from you to him in thanksgiving for his service and friendship to the people of this parish. Please show your appreciation for the time Fr Christopher spent in this parish and all he did here by contributing to the collection for his retirement at church this weekend. God bless, Fr Jonathon
