



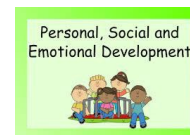
During the first term, the children in Reception class will be learning how to communicate with the adults in the class as well as with their peers. They will be learning about how to be a kind friend and how to interact with each other. They will be retelling stories and learning and discussing new vocabulary about the topic this term 'Marvellous Me'. They will be learning how to listen to others and building on their repertoire of songs and rhymes.



During the first term, the children will start their PE sessions and will be learning how to move in different ways. They will also be learning how to develop their fine motor skills by completing activities such as using scissors, peg boards, tweezers and threading. They will know where and how to wash their hands



This term the children will listen to and enjoy a wide range of books and learn how to handle and take care of books. They will start learning how to orally blend and segment and start learning the Phase 2 phonic sounds as well as the tricky words 'is', 'I' and 'the'. They will be taking part in mark making opportunities and will learn how to write their own name.



During the first term, the children will be learning how to follow the class rules and routines. They will be able to see themselves a valued individual and will be able to identify the three school values. They will be learning how to take responsibility and to recognise and manage their feelings. They will learn the importance of turn-taking.

During the first term, the children will learn how to count forwards and backwards to ten, recognise, say and identify numerals to ten and start subitising to five. We will use Numberblocks to introduce numbers and ensure the children understand the meaning of number.



The children will have the opportunity to talk and describe themselves and their families. They will describe the differences between themselves and others and talk about what makes them feel special. They will look at how happiness and sadness can be expressed and why being kind is good. In RE lessons we will be learning about how God created the world and that he knows that we are all very special.



The children will be learning how to use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques. They will be creating self portraits with detail. They will start learning a range of songs and rhymes and they will be able to join in with simple dances and clap to different rhythms.
