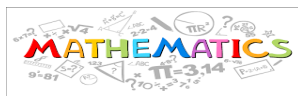




In English, we are going to be writing newspaper reports based on *Shackleton's Journey*. We will also write tourist brochures based on *The Baker by the Sea*.

This term, we will complete our Craft and Design: Fabric of nature unit. This will involve designing and creating artwork inspired by the rainforest.

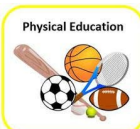


In Computing, we will develop our knowledge of computing systems and networks and will learn how to keep ourselves safe online.
