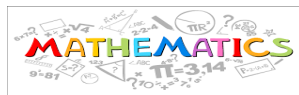




In English year 6 are going to be writing fairy tales as we read the book Grimm Tales for the Old and Young by Philip Pullman.



In mathematics this term the children are going to be looking at place value and rounding before moving on to the four operations: adding, subtraction, multiplying and dividing. The children will then start to tackle fractions.



In RE the children will be exploring creation. We will be talking about choice and free-will alongside learning about how God created the earth. The children will be asking questions about morality and choices.



In RSE the year 6 children will be investigating what the words gifts and talents means and what their own gifts and talents might be.



Science this term is animals including humans. We will be learning about the human body starting with how the human heart works.

The children will be learning about the Georgians in History.



This will be an exciting topic where they will investigate the defeat of Napoleon at Waterloo, the slave trade and the growth of the British empire.

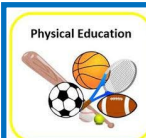
Curriculum Year 6 Autumn Newsletter
