



In English, we will be

This term, we will finish off our topic on decimals and fractions then we will calculate the area and perimeter of 2-D shapes and to finish the term, we will be able to identify, measure and draw angles.



Having celebrated Easter, we will now learn about Life in the Risen Jesus and consider the following questions: What is the meaning of the Resurrection? In which ways does the Spirit of Jesus work? In which ways is Jesus present among us? How is prayer important?



Our work will link to our online safety work in Computing, as we will be learning about cyberbullying. We will think about appropriate and inappropriate online behaviour and the consequences of unkindness.

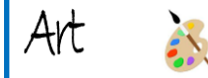


In Science, we will be beginning our new topic, 'Properties and Change of Materials' where we will learn about the properties of different materials and why certain materials are used to make products.
