



This term we are reading the book Pompeii, building on our ability to describe settings. 'Flotsam' is our second book and from this we will produce a 'message in a bottle' for our non-chronological report.



This term we will be covering Fractions recapping on the Numerator and the Denominator. The children will learn about unit & Non-unit Fraction and how to add and subtract them. We will then move on to Length & Perimeter.



Our focus this term is directed towards the celebration of Easter and the Pentecost. Looking at Jesus' resurrection, his appearance to the Apostles and his Ascension.
